

Prime Pastures Loan Terms and Conditions:

By agreeing to loan a horse or pony on our Prime Pastures Loan Scheme you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

- ✓ Veterinary visits annually in October (Silver Prime Pastures - horse not requiring regular medications) or twice annually, October and April (Gold Prime Pastures – horse requiring regular medications for a confirmed disease/pain management etc) to assess the horse's general health, known disease/mobility other ongoing health concerns. These visits are to be booked by the carer and must be arranged for April and October unless you are advised otherwise.
- ✓ Agree to keep The Sanctuary up to date with any changes in health, medications etc, for your Prime Pastures equine and to forward reports, x-rays, notes following veterinary, remedial farrier and dental checks when required.
- ✓ Agree to give your veterinary practice consent to discuss our equine(s) care and management directly with us in case this is ever required.
- ✓ The Mare and Foal Sanctuary reserves the right to refuse reimbursement of costs associated with flu and tetanus vaccinations, dental visits and any associated veterinary visits or treatments if they are not carried out within the timescales specified by the Sanctuary.
- ✓ Invoices for all Prime Pastures associated costs must be received by the Sanctuary's Accounts Department within 60 days of invoice. The Sanctuary reserves the right to refuse reimbursement for invoices received after this period.
- ✓ If you are no longer able to keep your Prime Pastures equine they must be returned to the Sanctuary accompanied by all remaining medications, equipment, wardrobe etc that has been purchased under the Prime Pastures agreement or provided by the Sanctuary specifically for the benefit of that equine.
- ✓ Items must be returned in the same condition they were sent out, i.e boots, new/nearly new condition or sweet itch rugs in useable condition, no rips/tears. If this is not possible a replacement of equal standard must be returned with the horse.
- ✓ The Mare and Foal Sanctuary reserves the right to amend/tailor the Prime Pastures loan scheme at any time dependent on an individual horse's health status and on advice from veterinary or other professional bodies.

Play School Loan Terms and Conditions.

By agreeing to loan a horse or pony on our Prime Play School Loan Scheme you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

- ✓ Agree to keep your Play School equine up to date with influenza and tetanus vaccinations as advised by The Sanctuary and to notify The Sanctuary after each vaccination.
- ✓ At maturity of your Play School equine you agree to discuss with The Sanctuary to determine which the best option is for the next stage of their life, i.e. retain (transferring to Standard Loan) as a companion to train the equine yourself or return the equine to the Sanctuary for backing and rehoming. This later option also gives you the opportunity to take on another foal under the Play School loan.
- ✓ The Mare and Foal Sanctuary reserves the right to refuse reimbursement of costs associated with influenza and tetanus vaccinations if they are not carried out within the timescales specified by the Sanctuary.
- ✓ Invoices for all Play School associated costs must be received by the Sanctuary's Accounts Department within 60 days of invoice. The Sanctuary reserves the right to refuse reimbursement for invoices received after this period.
- ✓ The Mare and Foal Sanctuary reserves the right to amend/tailor the Play School loan scheme at any time dependent on an individual horse's health status and on advice from veterinary or other professional bodies.
