



Prime Pastures Loan Terms and Conditions:

By rehoming a horse on our Prime Pastures Loan you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- ✓ Arrange for your own vet to visit & examine the horse annually or twice annually as agreed for your individual horse.
- ✓ Keep the Sanctuary up to date with any changes in the health, medication, care or management of your loan horse when requested.
- ✓ Give your veterinary practice consent to discuss your loan horse's care and management directly with the Sanctuary. Ensure that any veterinary reports & test results are forwarded to the Sanctuary straight away.
- ✓ The Mare and Foal Sanctuary reserves the right to refuse reimbursement of any agreed costs associated with Prime Pastures Loan if appointments are not carried out within the timescales specified by the Sanctuary.
- ✓ Invoices for all costs associated with Prime Pastures Loan must be received by the Sanctuary's Equine Department within 60 days of invoice. The Sanctuary reserves the right to refuse reimbursement for invoices received after this period.
- ✓ If you are no longer able to keep your Prime Pastures loan horse they must be returned to the Sanctuary accompanied by all remaining medications, equipment and any other items that have been purchased under the Prime Pastures agreement or provided by the Sanctuary specifically for the benefit of that equine.
- ✓ Items must be returned in serviceable condition, or a suitable replacement provided.
- ✓ The Mare and Foal Sanctuary reserves the right to amend the Prime Pastures Loan Terms and Conditions at any time, dependent on the individual needs of the horse.
